I joined RWS as an intern in June 2020 as part of my Master's program. Due to the pandemic, my onboarding in the company was entirely remote.

Initially I was part of the Junior Academy. I was trained on CAT tools and translation best practices. I was getting constant feedback on my work, which was very helpful which helped me strengthen my skills. I translated very diverse contents, mostly IT and marketing and occasionally medical or technical.

Besides translation, I also had the opportunity to work on other linguistic tasks such as ICL (Implementing Client Review), (LSO) Linguistic Sign Off or transcriptions.

In December 2020, I was offered a junior translator permanent position in the IT/Marketing team. I accepted the offer without any hesitation because RWS is a place with lots of opportunities where I can continue to learn and acquire new skills. I also liked the fact that I felt heard within the team and that my ambitions and preferences were taken into account.
